### Windridge's Programs

#### Windridge: Why we are unique

Windridge Therapeutic Equestrian Center is a faith-based nonprofit organization that offers equine-assisted activities and therapies (EAAT). Windridge provides services to children and adults with mental, emotional or physical disabilities.

Windridge is a premier accredited center with the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship, International (PATH Intl.) Once every five years a trained review committee visits and grades centers in accordance with PATH Intl. standards. The committee examines compliance in the areas of:

- · business and administration
- facility
- equine welfare and management
- medical/mental health regulations
- mounted activities

Accreditation through PATH Intl., is a voluntary process. A center must score 80% overall to be a Premier Accredited Center. Windridge has passed with 100% in all areas since first accredited in 1990.

Windridge is also a member of the American Hippotherapy Association (AHA). Hippo is Greek for horse. Windridge is a host site for AHA clinics for licensed therapists who wish to further their knowledge in hippotherapy treatment principles.

#### **Programs offered by Windridge:**

Windridge offers the following EAAT opportunities: Therapeutic Riding, Hippotherapy and Equines in Service to Heroes.

Therapeutic Riding is an equine-assisted activity and incorporates riding/ horsemanship skill to bring about positive changes in cognitive, physical, emotional and social well-being for individuals from 4 years old and up.

Hippotherapy is a treatment strategy utilized by a licensed therapist (i.e. physical, occupational, speech/language pathologist or behavior.) Kidz First Therapy works in conjunction with Windridge's PATH Intl. certified therapeutic riding instructors to offer services to individuals from 2 years old and up.

Equines in Service to Heroes is designed for persons either active or retired from military service. Mounted or un-mounted activities are incorporated to teach horsemanship skills tailored to the needs of the individual.

In the programs offered at Windridge, the quality three-dimensional movement of the horse is designed to promote progress in balance, coordination, core stability, strength of muscles, freedom of movement, language development, communication, problem solving, team building, selfconfidence and self-sufficiency.

Each program provides the opportunity to interact with peers, volunteers and instructors. This broadens a participant's attention span, the ability to follow instruction, aids in the ability to express oneself to others appropriately and develop useful life skills.

#### WINDRIDGE NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT!!

Windridge can only provide its unique programs for those in need through the support of the community. Most individuals who receive services do so due to the generosity of our East Texas Community. Windridge does not seek state or federal funding to provide much needed services to the people of our area.
